## Notes from 2019-2020 Planning

1. High Adventure Discussion
  - a. 2021 is the target for Sea Base – Dive Program
  - b. 2020 the window when more crew is available is either 2<sup>nd</sup> week in June before NYLT or after Camps end (since we have scouts staffing). Crew right now looking at early June for high adventure. The focus is:
    - i. Backpacking and/or Packrafting (some kind of back country high adventure) in Bob Marshall or other places where stuff happens of interest and we can get to it (north areas may not be accessible that early in June)
    - ii. Crew said they want ADVENTURE!
    - iii. Some ideas as well were grand canyon, canoeing, mountain biking, Glacier National Park.
  - c. Frank will look into ideas that meet the backcountry-adventure profile.
  - d. Program will require some conditioning!
